Hello. Attached is the recently update Pierce County Fire Resource plan. Here are the highlights of the changes.

1. The plan is in the midst of being loaded in the CAD at Firecomm. This will be the first time this document is automated. Thank you SS911 for jumping on this.
2. For In-County Responses, Firecomm will send you directly to the scene instead of to an assembly point.
3. For Out-of-County Responses, Firecomm will continue to have you assemble at a pre-designated assembly point.
4. "Zone Specific" task forces have been eliminated.
5. A Fire Resource Coordinator will be contacted/dispatched on the following alarms:
 - Residential 3rd
 - Commercial 2nd
 - Wildland 2nd
 - MCI's, Trains, Planes
6. There is increased depth in all categories of strike teams and task forces in the plan.
7. In the Pierce County Wide (PCW) section, Wildland has its own page with Brush Engines and Red-Carded leadership positions listed.
